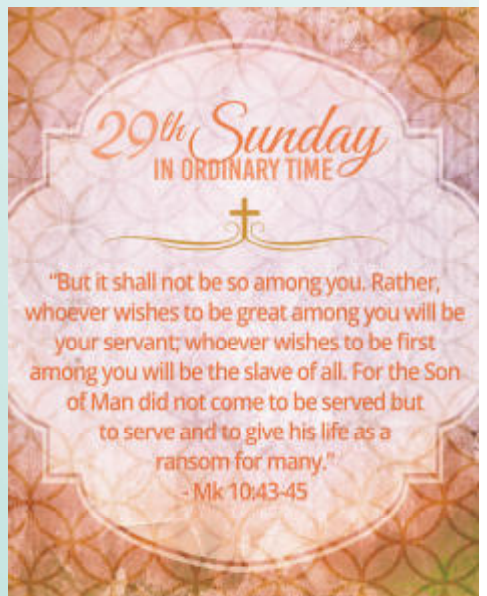

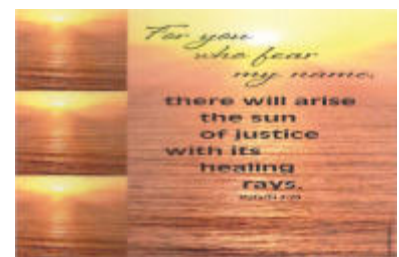
Baby Jayce, abortion pill survivor, through the help of David Bangs in 2017.
