What IS Going On At Mass?

"In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen."

As we transition from the opening hymn (where we are joined in communal praise of our Lord) to collectively making the Sign of the Cross (a familiar gesture that we often make without thinking) one might wonder why do we make the Sign of the Cross?

This gesture is not simply a way to begin or end a prayer. It is actually a powerful prayer in itself. A prayer to pour out tremendous blessings on our lives. We enter a sacred tradition when we make the Sign of the Cross. A tradition that dates back to the early centuries of Christianity. This ritual was understood to be a source of divine power and protection. In making this sign, we invoke the presence of God and invite him to bless us, assist us, and guard us from all harm.

This holy gesture points us to the Cross of Jesus—reminding us of his saving sacrifice—that place where Jesus gave everything out of love for us. The words we say help us recall that we are brought into the life of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We pray "in the name of" not "in the names of". Thus we are reminded of the one God in three persons—The Holy Trinity—that same three-in-one that was used to bless us at our Baptism. The Baptism which brought us into God's family.

The next time you make the Sign of the Cross, remember: the family of God into which you were baptized, the sacrifice which Christ made on that cross, and that you are invoking of the very presence of God,

"Do This In Remembrance of Me."
