What IS Going On At Mass?

After the Sign of the Cross Father greets us by saying one of the following:

“The Lord Be with you.”

“The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”

or

“Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ”.

This greeting is not your typical “Hello!” or “How are you?”. This greeting prompts us to recognize that we are moving into something out of the ordinary—something very special. It indicates that we are part of the universal celebration of the Liturgy—God with all his people.

This universal greeting helps us prepare to enter more fully into the celebration of the Mass. It further reminds us that this will be a sacred gathering with Almighty God present before us!

In all actuality, this greeting is a prayer wherein the priest is asking that the grace, peace, and love of God be with each person present.

We respond to the priest’s special prayer by saying “And with your spirit”. Why do we respond in this way?

We are addressing the “spirit” of the priest—that deepest interior part of his being where he has been ordained precisely to lead the people in this sacred action. We are recognizing and uniting ourselves with the spiritual gift he was given at ordination. We are acknowledging the Holy Spirit’s unique activity through the priest during the sacred liturgy. In essence, we are asking the one true priest, Christ Himself, to be present, through our priest, during our celebration of Mass.
