

what IS Going On At Mass?

Now that we have reminded ourselves of our Baptism (holy water), given reverence to Jesus present in the tabernacle (genuflection), and quietly prepared ourselves in prayer (silent meditation), we are all set for Mass to begin (Introductory Rites). Who knew there was so much "getting ready" to do before Mass?

The Introductory Rites typically begin with a Entrance Hymn. If no music is being played, as with daily morning mass, an Entrance Antiphon is recited.

Why do we sing?

When we **all** sing, we **unite** ourselves in praise of the Lord. All focus is placed on what is about to happen. We are unified in our attention toward the Mass. Singing requires more than speech. Singing involves both body and soul-putting your all into action.

It has been said that singing is "praying twice". Don't miss the opportunity. Don't let the Mass begin without you. Sing!

Be a part of this acclamation. Choosing not to sing, is a choice to ignore what is happening. Choosing not to sing is failing to unite with your fellow parishioners in praise of our Lord. Choosing not to sing is sending the message that you are not a part of what is occurring.
