## What IS Going On At Mass?

At the end of the Penitential Act the priest takes refuge with his people in the mercy of God: "May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life"

The Roman Missal refers to these words as "the absolution" and thus you might be thinking that this is another version of the forgiveness given during the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This is certainly not the case, as the Missal directly indicates that this prayer "lacks the efficacy of the Sacrament of Penance". The Penitential Act of the Mass is not a sacramental confession; therefore, it does not bring immediate remission of mortal sin.

Through the Penitential Act the priest makes a request for mercy, forgiveness, and everlasting life. Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation the priest, acting as the person of Christ, declares the pardon of sin in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. During the Penitential Act we inwardly acknowledge our sins—to ourselves. In Reconciliation we outwardly acknowledge them to the priest acting in the person of Christ. Therein lies the difference.

At this point in the Mass we have inwardly brought to mind our sins and in doing so identified areas of our lives in which we need God's mercy. It is a fitting place for us to recall what a wonderful Savior we have—how powerful the gift of his forgiveness truly is!
