What IS Going On At Mass?

After humbly calling to mind our sins during the Penitential Act and asking for God's mercy we do indeed realize the power of the gift of His forgiveness. What do we do next?

In praise, we come together in the Holy Spirit glorifying God the Father and the Lamb, by singing "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will."

The Gloria.

It is presented in three parts. In the first part we give praise to God the Father: "We praise you. We bless you. We adore you. We glorify you. We give you thanks for your great glory. Lord God, Heavenly King, oh God Almighty Father."

In the second part the praise is to God the Son: "Lord, Jesus Christ only begotten son. Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father. You take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. You take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer. You are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us."

The whole mission of Jesus is summed up in this section—his coming, his redeeming death, and his triumphant resurrection and ascension into heaven. We move from praising Jesus as the "only Begotten Son" of the Father who became flesh and dwelt among us; to worshipping him as the "Lamb of God" who by his sacrifice takes away the sin of the world; to praising him in his triumph over sin and death as he is "seated at the right hand of the Father."

In the third part of the Gloria our praise of Jesus Christ focuses on the Holy Trinity: For you alone are the Holy One. You alone are the Lord. You alone are the most high, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father.
