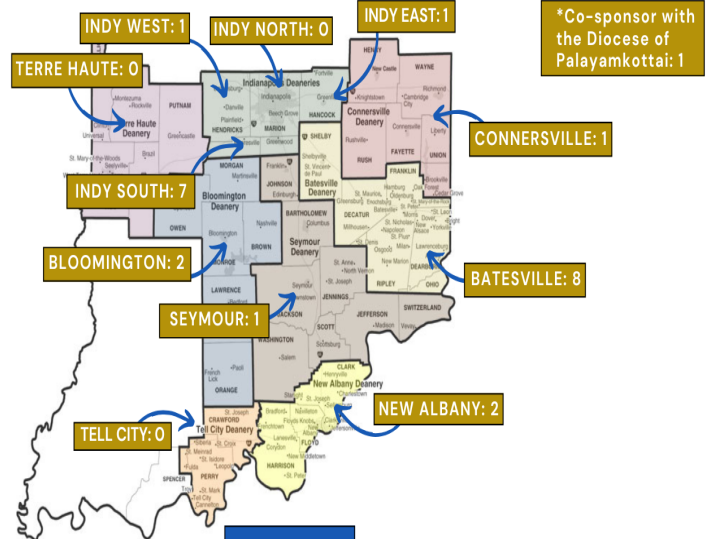

Because there is no definitive magisterial teaching on the moral liceity of embryo adoption, Catholics are called to form their opinions through a 'well-informed' conscience.
