



If you see him, say "hi" to... Deacon Joe (and Shelly) Beauchamp!



Deacon Joe Beauchamp was born in Houghton, MI, located on the northern tip of the UP. The oldest child of eight (four boys and four girls in alternating fashion), the family moved to OH, IL, and finally to his parent's hometown of Alpena, MI where he attended Alpena High School and met his wife, Shelly. He earned a Mechanical Engineering degree at Michigan Tech University, then moved to Indiana for his job at Allison Transmission (then a division of GM, on 10th St.). He vorked there for nearly 34 years in various engineering, supervisory and management roles, most recently as Director of Tooling, Chemical Engineering and Production Support.

He and Shelly raised three sons, who attended Center Grove High School in Greenwood. Deacon Joe's advice for young people as they grow spiritually and discern their path forward is to, "Be open to God's will in your lives, pray for Divine guidance and listen. Spend time in Eucharistic Adoration,

in the presence of Jesus. He will reveal God's plan for you."

Former parishioners of Our Lady of the Greenwood, when he applied to the Permanent Diaconate program there were two other men also selected from OLG, so he and another Deacon were assigned elsewhere. "Although I was 'told' to become a parishioner of St. Ann (in 2014) I can honestly say that I love my parish family and am truly happy here" despite the long drive! Formation is a 5-year process. The Archdiocese of Indianapolis only forms a class every 4-5 years. "The good Lord chased me around for 10 years before I finally said 'yes'!" The process of inquiry and discernment begins with a full year of once-a-month, two-hour meetings Sunday afternoons for the man and his wife. They travel to different churches in the Diocese, hearing testimony about different aspects of being a Permanent Deacon. Next, a 16 -page application (plus 8 pages for the wife, if applicable), in-person interview, and letters of recommendation from your pastor, secular work boss, and two Catholics in good standing. "When I finally applied there were 74 applicants and they selected 21 of us (here's your sign from the Holy Spirit!)." The next four years comprise class one weekend a month (Friday afternoon to Sunday evening) to read textbooks, take exams, write papers, and "yes, receive letter grades (A, B, C..)." The end result was the equivalent of a Masters in Theology, but instead, ordination. Most important to Deacon Joe about his Catholic faith is receiving the Eucharist. "This allows me to be part of the mystical body of Christ, this then empowers me to go out and evangelize to others through service to others.'

Congratulations on your retirement, Deacon Joe! Although involved at St. Ann with St. Vincent De Paul, Liturgy Committee, OCIA instruction, Baptismal Prep Classes, Training for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors, and Altar Servers; Prison Ministry, Assisted Living visits, Eucharistic Adoration, Parish Staff, and occasionally Parish Council, may you also find time for designing/building (always a Mechanical Engineer at heart) as well as hunting and shooting sports on your 45-acre oasis, a small "off-the-grid" cabin in Greene County (south of Bloomington). We thank you and Shelly for being a Marriage Sponsor couple and hope you enjoy spending more time with your five grandchildren!
