



"Look at all the family we have" she realized upon her cousin's recent passing. Elisa's legacy is making more connections between family in Mexico and here in Indianapolis. She was born and raised Catholic in



Mexico, where her father, older sister and many other relatives still live. Sadly, she lost her mother to cancer. Her younger sister lives in California, and her brother- the youngest sibling - lives in Indianapolis. Elisa has two daughters, ages 10 and 19, and a son, age 20. All attended Decatur schools. Her oldest daughter is at IU.

Previously a member of St. Mary's and single mom working 12 hours a day 6-7 days a week, trying to get to early Mass resulted in Elisa coming to St. Ann - which was closer and smaller - five years ago and having her children baptized. Fast forward to choir practice at St. Ann Wednesday evenings where Elisa lends her beautiful voice in both Spanish and English. When she joined St. Ann, Elisa was eager to get involved, but did not know how to do so. Her suggestion to make new parishioners who want to be at St. Ann feel like an appreciated member is to provide them a Welcome Kit: a Rosary, a prayer card for the home/family, a bulletin and a blank sheet of paper to detail in any language what they need and can help out with. Letting them know about the sign-up sheets on the bulletin board would also help so someone could contact them. Elisa is willing to assist with Welcome

Kits and has great ideas for including more parishioners, like projecting responses on the church wall/screen in both English and Spanish so those who speak primarily Spanish have an opportunity to participate and pray in Spanish as well as "learn new things".

Elisa is a caring supervisor at Whirlpool in Plainfield. When greeting new employees, she lets them know that making sure they are safe doing their job is her primary concern. She also works at nurturing her faith through prayer. Having faced many challenges, Elisa always ends up turning back to God. Perhaps one prayer answered would be realizing the memory of Christmas as a time her Mother's side of the family would gather and celebrate. ¡Feliz Navidad!
