

If you see Linda (and Greg) Kile, be sure and say "hi"...

... and congratulations! Their son, Jimmy, just got married last Saturday! He is 30 and his brother, Robby, 28. Both attended St. Barnabas and Roncalli. In fact, between layoffs Linda and Greg put in a lot of sweat equity to pay tuition, including working concessions at Lucas Oll and Victory Field. They have always done what they needed to do to make ends meet. At one point when the paper and pulp industry was waning, Greg had a successful eBay business selling items from his movie memorabilia collection.

They met at a gaming convention in Cincinnati when the industry was just taking off. At that time, Greg was working at a bookstore that was one of the bigger gaming stores around and Linda attended the conference on behalf of the hobby store where she worked. Hanging out at the Ohio bookstore for gaming nights Saturdays, they eventually started dating and have been married 33 years. Divine providence did not seem to be at play when they were out of work, working five jobs between the two of them, figuring out how to drive two moving trucks from Charlotte, NC back to the midwest (Linda ended up driving one while 34 weeks pregnant with Jimmy), or when Greg was transferred to CO, but in fact it was.

Greg and Linda helped start Ave Maria Catholic School in Parker, CO which their sons attended until they moved. Linda was a stay-at-home mom to their 3- and 17-month old boys while in CO because Greg traveled a lot for work, but even more so because they strongly believed that it is up to parents to teach morals and values. Greg and Linda took a leap of faith and put their house in CO on the market to be in OH with her family. Turned out that her mother and sister were moving back to Cincinnati as well!

Fast forward to job transfers for both to Indy. Linda was working for Republic Airlines when she talked to Fr. Jerry Byrd at St. Barnabas during a Lenten retreat about a calling to take over day-to-day operations of The Gabriel Project. Following Fr. Jerry's advice to spend the rest of Lent in deep discernment about God's call, Linda prayed a 9-hour Novena not knowing how, with Greg unemployed at the time, teenage sons, 5 cats, and her having benefit coverage for the family, was going to make the break from the secular world to help launch a mobile pregnancy center. Praying for guidance while driving to work one day, Linda learned four hours later she had been laid off. Greg is trained and currently employed in IT.

The Great Lakes Gabriel Project is growing under <u>Linda's leadership</u> as Executive Director. Linda had an epiphany when overloaded with donations for The Gabriel Project "to do on the west side what we were



doing for women on the east side". Linda and Greg had been involved with the St. Ann festival and book club (joining the parish just after Fr. Jude arrived), so asked Fr. Rob for help. The St. Joseph Resource Center was opened shortly thereafter.

Renovations should be complete early 2025 for the opening of 1st Choice for Women, located on Kentucky Ave., providing free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds. Multilingual prenatal classes and curriculum on parenting, co-parenting in different households, and budgeting allows attendees to earn points for free baby products.

How can we help? The resource center is currently overstocked on clothes, but needs infant bathtubs, turning time activity mats and umbrella strollers - new or gently used. Monetary donations can be made via check, payable to The Gabriel Project and given to Linda or mailed to: PO Box 422, Camby, IN 46113, or online at goangels.org. Linda clearly counts her blessings and pays them forward to families in need.
