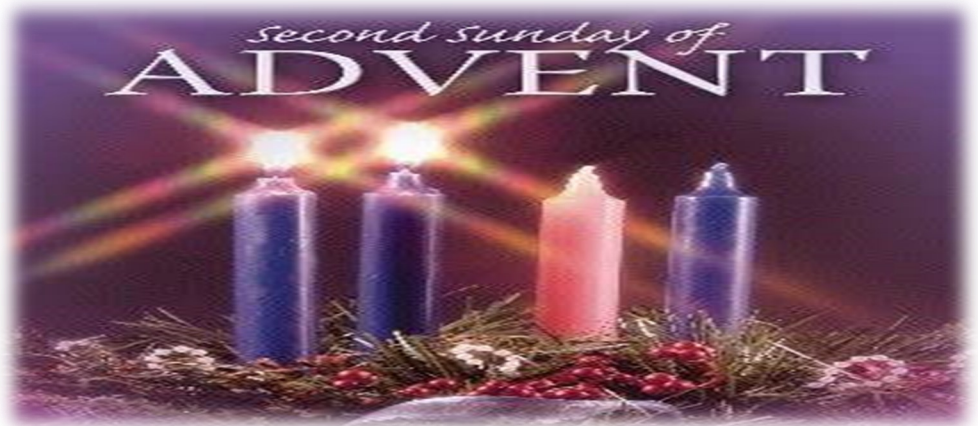

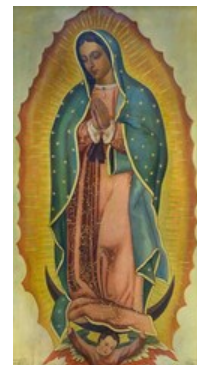

Peace

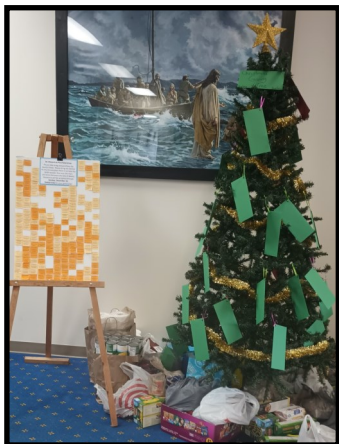
