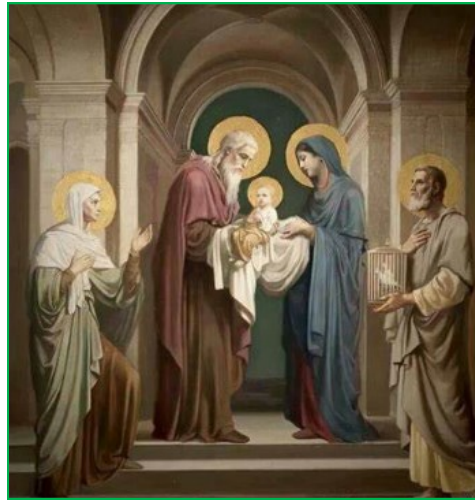

When you see them, say "hi" to... Tommy & Ashley Guilfof!

You may have many things in common with Tommy and Ashley! "We make it a point to attend Mass (if even not at St. Ann's) every weekend, every holy day, and whenever we feel called. We are still working on our faith and prayer life day by day, but are so proud to be Catholic and to work towards growing deeper in our faith little by little." What is most important to both? "How we will one day teach and raise our children in our Catholic Faith. Our future children's faith formation and growth are very important to us" and recognize that it begins with their own faith. "We would love to see a younger population start to enter St. Ann's. We want our future children to not feel alone in their faith journey when it comes to other children, and from what we have noticed- there are not many young children in our community."

Tommy grew up in Brownsburg and Ashley in Carmel. He attended Cardinal Ritter and she Guerin Catholic High School. They met at Marian University where both began in elementary education (Ashley has her bachelor's), but Tommy switched to applied educational studies.

Tommy works for Amazon in a warehouse setting as an assistant manager. Ashley works as a 1st grade teacher at Little Flower Catholic School, hoping one day to become an instructional coach (she holds her master's degree in building level administration). Tommy likes to work for and volunteer his time in theaters, with which Ashley helps. "We both like to spend time with family, volunteer, explore new cities, and enjoy a good home project."

Both came from St. Christopher's to become St. Ann parishioners in 2021. Having moved closer, there was the convenience factor, but they had not found their place in that community so considered other parishes. Both "love the people we have gotten to know at St. Ann, (but) when we joined, it was difficult for us to find our spot...being younger than most of the parish. We also struggled because someone (who has since passed) thought they knew us and would corner us to talk to us and would often kiss Tommy on his cheek. We were very worried we did not make the right decision at first moving parishes. We stuck with St. Ann and we found our place once we really got to know others and volunteer our time. We still have not found very many younger parishioner friends and would love to connect sometime!"

Tommy and Ashley serve in many volunteer roles at St. Ann, including Tommy representing Faith Formation on Parish Council for the past 2 years and Ashley cantoring at Mass. "We would love to see more diversity embraced, especially in our music ministry. Cultural exposure to us is so important... to know others' traditions and cultures." Both worked together to organize Vacation Bible School. Tommy helps with technology at various events as well. "We want to serve and help others with our time and talent as much as we can... St. Ann's has a great base for habitual volunteers-people you can always rely on."

"We love St. Ann's and want to help build a community where all are welcome no matter their background." Tommy and Ashley plan to serve and help others with their time and talent as much as they can, hope to get to know more young families in the future, and "would love to get to know more of our parish."
