St. Ann Parish has been given a goal of **\$18,561** for the **UNITED CATHOLIC APPEAL**.

As of 02/11/24 **forty-five** of **St. Ann's parishioners** have pledged a total of **\$12,621**. This is **68%** of our goal.

Within the Archdiocese of Indianapolis **\$4.9 million** has been pledged toward a goal of **\$6.3 million**.

What Is Going On At Mass?

Father has just concluded another of his poignant homilies. He returns to the altar and standing there in silence he gives us pause to contemplate his message. Breaking the silence, he speaks these words, "Profession of Faith." We stand and begin to profess, The Creed. Whether it be the Apostles' Creed or the Nicene Creed it begins with "I believe". The word "Creed" comes from the Latin Credo, meaning "I believe" and is a collection of core truths in which our belief is placed.

The Catechism contends that "these two creeds have a special place in the Church's life. The Apostles' Creed is so called because it is rightly considered to be a faithful summary of the apostles' faith. The Nicene (Niceno-Constantinopolitan) Creed draws its great authority from the fact that it stems from the first two ecumenical Councils (of Nicaea in 325 and of Constantinople in 381). It remains common to all the great Churches of both East and West to this day" Although either may be used at Mass, we most often hear the Nicene Creed.

The Creed, or Profession of Faith stems from the Ancient Church. This statement of belief was not originally written to be recited at Mass; it was rather intended as a prerequisite "contract" for adult baptism. One would profess these essential truths of the faith before being admitted, through baptism, into the Church. Eventually, the Creed would be inserted into the Mass as it is today. Because the Creed is a great summary of the truths of the Faith, knowing the Creed is a wonderful way to know the foundations of the faith and to keep those basics fresh in our minds and hearts.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) states, "The purpose of the Creed or Profession of Faith is that the whole gathered people may respond to the Word of God proclaimed in the readings taken from Sacred scripture and explained in the Homily and that they may also honor and confess the great mysteries of the faith by pronouncing the rule of faith in a formula approved for liturgical use and before the celebration of these mysteries in the Eucharist begins."

As we profess our faith together, we are joined in a unity that began at our Baptism. To say the Creed with faith is to enter into communion with God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and also with the whole Church which transmits the faith to us and in whose midst we believe.
