## Lenten Resources 2023

**Fasting and Abstinence:** Abstain from hurtful words. Pause before responding to someone out of anger or resentment. Substitute words of healing and consideration.

**Almsgiving/Sharing Your Resources:** Offer to help someone else in the family, at work, or in school with a chore or task.

**Prayer and Worship:** Make a list of people who need your prayers. Set aside time each day this week to remember them in your morning or evening prayers.

**When going to Confession:** Reconciliation may be face-to-face or anonymous, with a screen between you and the priest. Choose the option that is the most comfortable for you.

1. The priest gives a blessing or greeting.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross and say, "Bless me father, for I have sinned. My last confession was...ago". (give weeks, months or years).
3. Confess all your sins to the priest. (if you are unsure or uneasy, let father know and ask for help.)
4. Say, "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest gives a penance and offers advice to help you become a better Catholic Christian.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for you sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.

### Act of Contrition:

God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you, and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of hell; but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to confess my sins, do penance, and amend my life. **Amen.**
