What Is Going On At Mass?

We have been nourished by the Word of God, professed our faith, and sent up our prayers for the people. Now, we sit and wait as the Liturgy of the Eucharist begins.

This is an active time during the Mass, as there are many moving parts. The priest begins preparing the Altar, the servers are scurrying about assisting him, the ushers are taking up the collection, and members from the congregation are moving into place to carry the gifts forward.

That's a lot of activity. What does it all mean?

Before Jesus sat down with his disciples to celebrate the Last Supper, he instructed that various preparations be made. Securing and preparing a room, making bread, and the purchasing of wine all needed to be done before this sacred event could take place. The same is true when we celebrate Mass. The elements for the table must be readied.

These items are needed for the Liturgy of the Eucharist:

Two to six lighted candles.

A crucifix on or near the cloth-covered altar.

The Missal: The big red book from which the priest reads.

Corporal: The square white cloth that is unfolded and placed on the altar. Since the cloth derives its name from the word meaning body, it makes sense that the Body and Blood of Christ will become present upon it during Mass.

Chalice: The special cup which will contain the precious Blood of Christ.

Purificator: A long and narrower white cloth that is used to wipe the rim of the chalice.

Paten: The small plate which is used for the large host the priest holds up during the Eucharistic Prayer.

Ciborium: The vessel with a matching lid which holds the smaller hosts. When hosts are reserved in the tabernacle, they rest in a ciborium.

These items and more are prepared and positioned on or near the altar by either the priest or the altar servers. Many of them are made of precious metals (gold-plated or silver-plated) because we use the most precious materials we have to honor Jesus truly there in his most precious Body and Blood.

The table is set.

Typically, during this very active time there is music playing. Music aids us in being more prayerfully present and in the proper mindset to approach the table of the Lord to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

Have you ever noticed that songs at this point in the Mass are often slower in tempo, and more flowing in words? This is to foster our focus on the most beautiful mystery taking place in front of us: Jesus Christ's one perfect sacrifice before the Father is made present to his spouse, the Church, and the bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ.

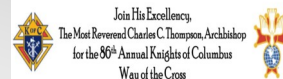
