

Governor Braun to address Catholic Business Exchange

Mike Braun, Indiana's 52nd Governor, will address the March Catholic Business Exchange. His theme will be: A Fireside Chat with Governor Mike Braun.

Governor Braun received his undergraduate degree from Wabash College and an MBA from Harvard Business School. After business school, he returned to his hometown of Jasper and worked for a national kitchen cabinet company. In 1981, he took over a farm equipment manufacturer called Meyer Body and grew it from 15 employees to a national company that today has thousands of employees in 38 states. He was a State Representative from 2014-2017, was elected to the U.S. Senate in 2018 and became the 52nd Governor of Indiana in January of this year. Mike and Maureen have been married 48 years and attend St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper. They have four adult children and seven grandchildren.

The event is March 20, at the Northside Events and Social Club. Mass is offered at 7am and the program will be finished by 9am. Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation for Roman Catholics, yet receiving ashes is a universal practice among Christians to begin their Lenten Journeys. For this reason, you do NOT need to be Catholic to receive ashes on Ash Wednesday.

The ashes, in the form of a cross, mean that we are making a commitment—that we are undertaking Lent as a season of prayer and penitence, of dying to ourselves. It also describes our human condition: it says that we are broken and need repair; that we are sinners and need redemption.

Most importantly, it tells us that, as followers of Jesus Christ, we are to carry our crosses and remember our mortality—from dust we came; and unto dust we shall return.
