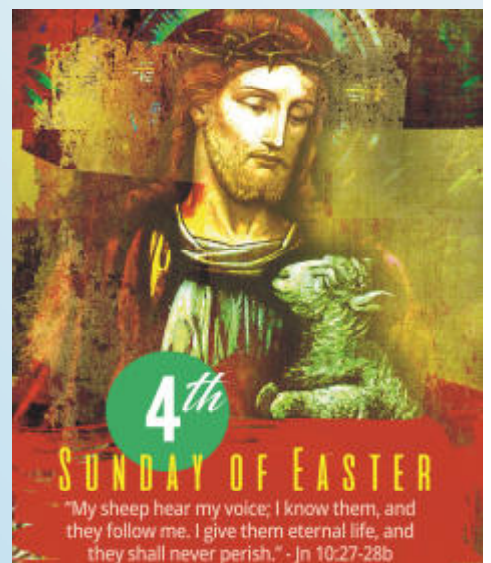

He said the diocese is down 11 priests from last year. He has asked for prayers for himself and for the diocese that we could acquire more priests.

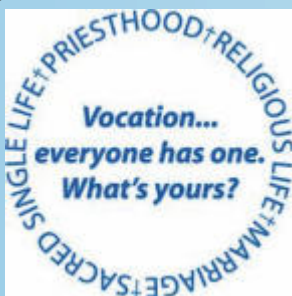


Prayer for Vocations

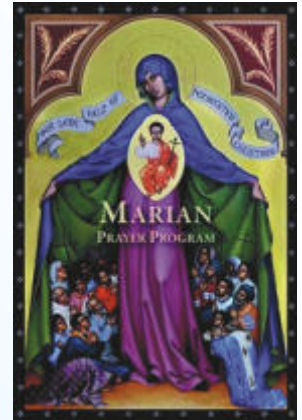

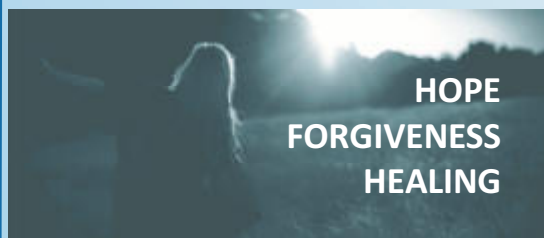
Blessed are those who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Mt 5:10)
