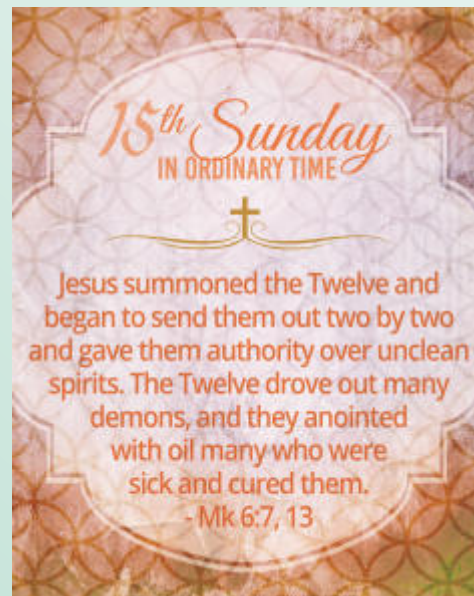

Started in 2011, our Bicycles for the Homeless Ministry has given out over 1,700 bicycles. Our homeless neighbors need transportation to get to jobs, medical appointments, social service agencies, etc. We can accept just about any used bicycle as long as it is in ride-able condition - we have volunteers that can make minor repairs. Along with the bikes, we give accessories if they are available through donations: a backpack, helmet and lock, and all bikes are equipped with lights and reflectors. When possible, we like to include useful items in the backpacks. We observe the recipient riding the bike to ensure ability to safely ride it. You can drop off your bikes, helmets, locks and backpacks at the SVdP Distribution Center, 1201 E. Maryland Street. 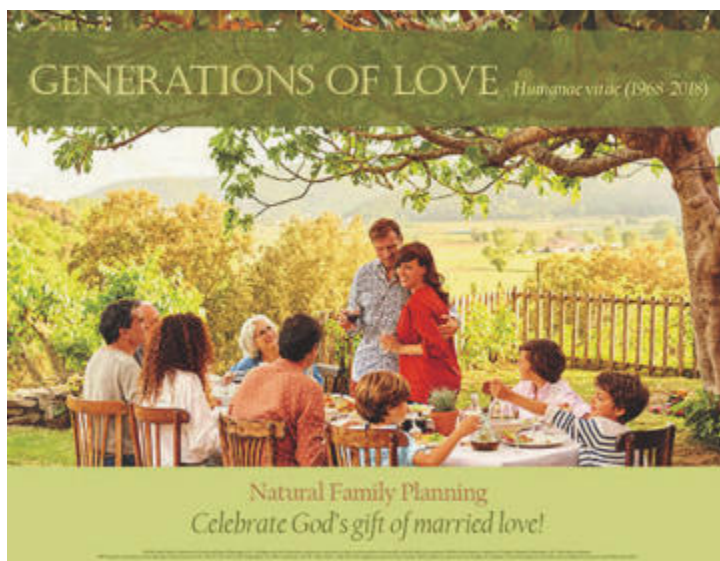


