With this system you can use your smart phone and ear buds/hearing aids to better hear what is going on at Mass.

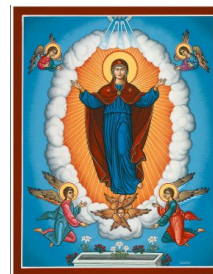

St. Ann Parish, Indianapolis, Indiana, a bilingual (Spanish/English) community, is accepting applications for the part-time position of Coordinator of Faith Formation, twenty-five hours per week, for children and adolescents and adults.

**I. Primary responsibilities:** Develops/Coordinates Catechists to support the religious/faith formation programs. Oversee the Sunday religious formation program (pre-K-8th grade) students. Sacramental preparation for children enrolled in Sunday religious education (first reconciliation, first communion and confirmation). Oversees the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, the Quinceañera preparation and the summer Vacation Bible School.
