St. Ann Parish, Indianapolis, Indiana, a bilingual (Spanish/English) community, is accepting applications for the part-time position of Coordinator of Faith Formation, twenty-five hours per week, for children and adolescents and adults.

I. Primary responsibilities: Develops/Coordinates Catechists to support the religious/faith formation programs. Oversee the Sunday religious formation program (pre-K-8th grade) students. Sacramental preparation for children enrolled in Sunday religious education (first reconciliation, first communion and confirmation).
