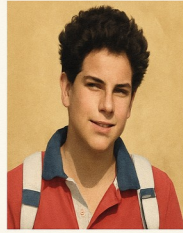

St. Ann Parish, Indianapolis, Indiana, a bilingual (Spanish/English) community, is accepting applications for the part-time position of Coordinator of Faith Formation, twenty-five hours per week, for children and adolescents and adults.

I. Primary responsibilities: Develops/Coordinates Catechists to support the religious/faith formation programs. Oversee the Sunday religious formation program (pre-K-8th grade) students. Sacramental preparation for children enrolled in Sunday religious education (first reconciliation, first communion and confirmation). Oversees the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, the Quinceañera preparation and the summer Vacation Bible School. Additionally, coordinate adult faith formation opportunities with the Director of Liturgy and the pastor. Salary will be commensurate with experience and education.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

- The Director of Faith Formation should be a practicing Catholic with knowledge of the Church's teachings, liturgy, and structure.

- An ideal bilingual candidate will have experience as a teacher or catechist
