What IS Going On At Mass?

It all begins as you enter the nave of the church. You dip a finger into the holy water and bless yourself with the sign of the cross. Have you ever wondered why? What is the purpose of this gesture?

In many traditional church layouts, the baptistry was located near the main door of the church. As the Sacrament of Baptism is our entrance into the life of Christ and the Christian Faith, so too are the holy water and baptismal fonts placed there (near the entrance) to symbolically recall for us our entrance into the life of the Church. It reminds us of our baptism with water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit (the Sign of the Cross). By blessing ourselves with holy water, we recommit ourselves to living holy lives in fidelity to Christ, and we prepare ourselves to participate fruitfully in the Holy Mass.

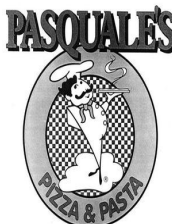
