## What IS Going On At Mass?

Following your entrance into church and blessing yourself with holy water you begin looking for a place to sit. Before sliding into the pew Catholics genuflect. What is this gesture and why is it done?

Genuflecting is a physical gesture of touching your right knee to the floor. It is done as a sign of honor and respect for the true presence of Jesus Christ.

He's here? Jesus is really here? Where?

In the tabernacle, in the Blessed Sacrament. His presence there is communicated to those in attendance by the red candle burning in the sanctuary near the tabernacle.

So, the next time you enter a Catholic church, look to the altar, to the crucifix, to the tabernacle and look for that burning candle. If it is there and burning, remember He is also there.

Before taking a seat show your respect and adoration for His true presence. Genuflect!

For those with mobility issues a simple bow is appropriate.
