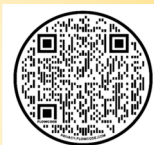

## Bobby Kloska to address Catholic Business Exchange



Robert "Bobby" Kloska, Chief Partnership Officer of the Notre Dame Federal Credit Union and proprietor of St. Peter's Pub at the University, will speak at the November Catholic Business Exchange. The title of his talk is: "Faith Through the Fight: My Journey with Cancer".

Since 2003, he has experienced three separate occurrences of cancer which have led to chemotherapy, radiation, two stem cell transplants, 30+ surgeries, a heart attack, three coronary stents, two incurable viruses, chronic blood issues, and countless hospitalizations and outpatient IV treatments. In 2014, Bobby was hired at Notre Dame Federal Credit Union to help develop and implement the CEO's vision for a national Catholic financial ecosystem. Today, Notre Dame FCU has contributed to the well-being of three dozen dioceses nation-wide, funding Catholic radio stations, schools, and parishes. Among his many other accomplishments, he might be most notably known as the proprietor of St. Peter's Pub, a 110-year-old backyard carriage house which has been converted into a Catholic friendly social hub for the university community, along with neighbors, family and friends.

The event is November 15, at the Northside Events and Social Club. Mass is offered at 7am and the program will be finished by 9am. Cost for the program includes a great breakfast and is \$18 in advance for members and \$24 for non-members. Registration is required by 4pm, Tuesday November 12. "I'm not as scary as I look," does not reveal just how welcoming Donna is; no matter how busy, you have her undivided attention. And a laugh or two. With a great sense of humor and outlook on life, Donna wears many hats at St. Ann. You might know her as: the person who takes Communion to shut ins, Sacristan, EMHC Chairperson - making sure there are enough Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at Mass, the Resource Desk "person to ask if you don't know" before and after masses, Coordinator of Adoration the first Tuesday of each month.... to name a few of the abundant gifts of time and talent she shares.

Donna became a St. Ann parishioner in 1977 when she and her husband found a house in the Camby area. She was pregnant with her oldest, Dean. Both Dean and sister Adele attended St. Ann Catholic School and took part in Religious Education through high school. Donna didn't want to overwhelm her children like she was growing up, but wanted to provide them a solid faith foundation no matter how much pushback she got from them.

Her faith is very important to Donna: "I share it the best I can." The oldest of five children, Donna was born in Detroit September 1950, baptized October 1, 1950 (her mom and dad's wedding anniversary) and attended Mass every morning as a child. "It was important, no matter how early or difficult, to go and be at Church." Her family moved to South Bend where Donna was enrolled in St. Matthew, which along with the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Fort Wayne was named a Co-Cathedral in 1969. Once construction was complete, the Cathedral of St. Matthew became the seat of Bishops. Beginning in 6th grade, Donna attended St. Pius X in Indianapolis, graduated from Chatard (now Bishop Chatard) in 1968, and married in 1975.

When she has a spare minute, she enjoys crocheting and visiting her daughter in Carmel (Dean lives closer). Donna has six grandchildren ages 16-21. The oldest turned 21 last Saturday!

Where would Donna like to see St. Ann five years from now? As more culturally diverse, including a Spanish Mass at least once a month. "We're universal - that's our main goal. We are all baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit." As for Adoration, there is someone to cover each hour, but subs are needed! Perhaps the signs that will be on display Election Day asking for silence while Adoration is in progress will generate interest. Donna recently helped a young parishioner meet a Boy Scout badge requirement by taking him to Adoration with mom's permission. "You gotta start there."

As for the "scary" look, Donna is very easy to talk to! "I'm a marshmallow on the inside."
