If you see her, say "hi" to... Monica Gilbrech!

Monica has 2 jobs in addition to her family responsibilities: 911 Dispatcher & Trainer for Marion Co. 911 (Metropolitan Emergency Services Agency); a "stressful job, but can be rewarding at times, as I love knowing I have helped someone in their time of despair" and coordinator of St. Ann Music Ministry (a volunteer position). You may recognize Monica from VBS, hosting "Acts & Snacks", volunteering at the St. Ann festival, as a Liturgy Commission member, or as a lector, accompanist and cantor. She is also 1 of 7 siblings who take turns being with and caring for her dad in his state of dementia and old age.

Born in Coleman Hospital on the IU(PUI) campus, Monica attended IPS #49 for Kindergarten, then All Saints Catholic School thru 8th Grade, Cardinal Ritter High School, and IUPUI for her IU Bachelor of Arts degree. She is the 9th child of 10 born to Joseph W. King, Jr. (who turns 90 on 12/30/24!) and Evelyn E. Mueller King (who died in 1994). As Monica tells it, "I hold the title of 'Baby Girl' in our large Catholic family, as I am the youngest of their 7 daughters. I have 1 younger brother and 2 older brothers. My younger brother always tries to tell me, 'They stopped at perfection.'"



Of importance to Monica in her personal faith journey is to "maintain a deeper feeling of faith for what cannot always be seen." When asked about advice for young people as they grow spiritually and discern their path forward, Monica suggests putting God first. "Talk to God in quiet times; thank Him for what you have, where you come from, and look to Him for answers on where you are heading."

Monica joined St. Ann in 2009 with her 3 daughters, Julia, Elizabeth, and Audrey, then ages 7, 4, and 2 (Note: photo is from 2020 St. Ann directory). Prior to that, "as a single mom I was running us around to a variety of southside or Greenwood parishes, often attending Sacred Heart, St. Barnabas, and/or SS. Francis and Clare. Although we do not live in Decatur Township, we do live in nearby Perry Township and back in 2008, often I would drive by the 'Coming Soon' sign posted on the building grounds for the new St. Ann so figured we would give it a try once it opened. We attended the opening Mass, and I found that the parishioners were all very down-to-earth, and it felt like a welcoming group of people. Shortly into regularly attending mass at St. Ann and becoming an official member of the parish, former parishioner Linda Staten recognized my voice from the pews and invited me to join the choir. I suppose, as they say, the rest is history."

When she was little, Monica would try to sound out songs and "play by ear" on her family's player piano. She started weekly piano lessons in 2nd grade from Sr. Catherine Marie Qualters, S.P. at the All Saints (St. Anthony) convent. Sister taught her to play chords with her left hand and the melody with her right. Monica continued piano lessons throughout high school with a professional pianist (studio teacher). She played in recitals as well as playing the organ for Assumption Catholic Church weekly masses from 5th grade until 1994 when the parish closed its doors for good. "They once highlighted me in the Criterion for being the archdiocese's youngest Music Minister. All of my older siblings took piano lessons, but I was the only one with whom it 'stuck.' I was so blessed to have inherited the player piano from our childhood home and moved it to my own home several years ago. It is an Apollo Melville Clark from 1910. The player portion does not function, but the ivory keys are still marvelous for an almost 115-year-old piano." Monica, an excellent pianist and vocalist, loves to play "as both a hobby and a form of relaxation and mental therapy." She was in high school choirs and 1 year of college choir. "I have always loved to sing in choirs and miss that kind of comradery with fellow musicians."

Fluent in Spanish, a wonderful sense of humor, and a joy to work with, Monica asks that any St. Ann vocalists and instrumentalists please come forward! You will be in good company and your God-given talent is needed! She suggests letting a quote attributed to St. Augustine inspire you: "He who sings prays twice." Come musically pray with us!
