Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Lessons to be Learned

The miracle of the loaves and fishes is one of the best known in the Gospels. When Jesus performs a miracle, He is not trying to show off his power. His actions always illustrate a lesson. This miracle can teach us many things. Let's look at a few of them.

One is the compassion of Christ. He takes pity on the crowd and first shows his love by curing their sick. Then He sees that they are hungry and He feeds them. This reminds us that Jesus will give us Himself, his Body and Blood as bread and wine to be our food and drink.

So, the question is, do we learn from this miracle? Do we trust the Lord to care for all our needs? Do we try to live by God's word? And finally, do we take advantage of the great gift of the Eucharist? The miracle may have happened two thousand years ago, but the lessons are meant for us today.

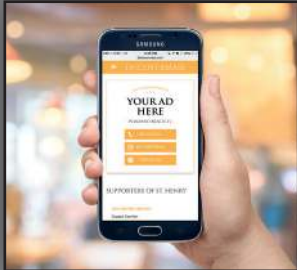
